Compliance with HB 3693

CAPP members will comply with the requirements of HB 3693 (Government Code § 2264.001(b)) by compiling and posting the following information as soon as practicable after January 1, 2011:

- 1) The total metered amount of electricity, water, and natural gas used by the city or governmental entity for its services in 2010. The annual metered amounts can be separately listed for each utility service without violating confidentiality terms.
- 2) The total amount paid for electricity, water, and natural gas in 2010. The total annual cost paid for the three utility services should be posted as one figure.

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2010

The City of Belton purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In Calendar Year 2010, the City purchased a total of 1,286 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Direct Energy. In calendar year 2010, the City purchased a total of 2,371,531 kilowatt hours.

The City is a municipal water supplier and as a self-supplier, no municipal funds are expended to purchase water for municipal services. In calendar year 2010, the City consumed a total of 15,900,100 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas and electricity purchased by the City in the calendar year 2010 is \$391,278.
