

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2012

The City of Kenedy purchases natural gas from Center Point Energy. In calendar year 2012, the city purchased a total of 50.9 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from CPL, Direct Energy, and Karnes Electric Cooperative. In calendar year 2012, the City purchased a total of 5,969,287 kilowatt hours.

The City is a self supplier for water. In calendar year 2012, the City used a total of 1,486,300 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas and electricity purchased by the City in the calendar year 2012 is \$544,280.55. No municipal funds are expended to purchase water for municipal services.
