

City of Frisco Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2019

The City of Frisco purchases natural gas from Atmos and CoServ. In Calendar Year 2019, the City purchased a total of 9.5 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from GEXA Energy and CoServ.[1] In calendar year 2019, the City purchased a total of 4,911,505 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from NTMWD.[2] In calendar year 2019, the City purchased a total of 1,258,691 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity, and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2019 is \$6,165,129.

The total cost of electricity, gas, and water purchased by the City of Frisco in the calendar year 2019 was \$6,165,129. The total invoiced kWhs (kilowatts) for electricity for 2019 was 4,911,505.
