

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2012

The City of Bishop purchases natural gas from Center Point Energy. In Calendar Year 2012, the City purchased a total of 330 cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas, (1CCF=100 cubic feet of gas)

The City purchases electricity from Direct Energy. In calendar year 2012, the City purchased a total of 775,099 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from South Texas Water Authority. In calendar year 2012, the City purchased a total of 83,976,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2012 is \$248,965.86
